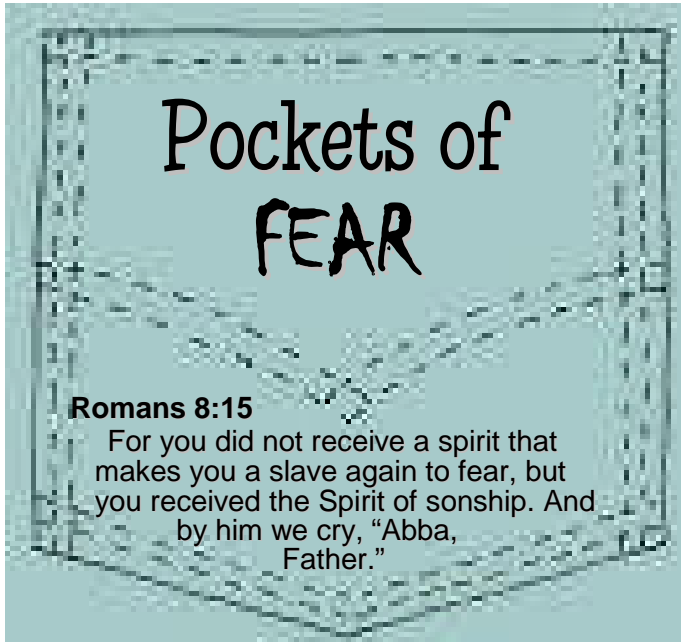


Pockets of FEAR

Matthew 6:25 – 26
