Participant Guidelines

Anchored exists to create a Christ-centered community in which women can gather and seek God together through prayer. To preserve a spirit of unity, trust, and spiritual growth, we ask each participant to agree to the following guidelines:

1. Anchored in God's Word

The Bible is our foundation and final authority. Scripture shapes our prayers, conversations, and encouragement as we seek to grow deeper in faith and obedience to Christ.

2. A Safe Space

Anchored is a place of trust, respect, and confidentiality. What is shared in the group remains within the group.

3. Christ-Centered

To protect unity and focus, political discussions or debates are not part of Anchored gatherings. Our time together is devoted to prayer, Scripture, and spiritual encouragement.

4. Commitment to Community

To create communities of trust and meaningful relationships, we ask participants to attend **at least two meetings per month**, except in cases of illness or unavoidable circumstances.

5. Prayer as Our Primary Purpose

While fellowship is a gift, prayer is our primary focus. To ensure each woman has space to share and be prayed for, we ask everyone to be mindful of time and to make room for others to participate.





Statement of Faith

The Christian Working Woman is a faith-based organization. It is important that all Equipped Influencers are in agreement with the doctrinal statement. Also, we welcome any questions you might have regarding the statement.

1. We believe all Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, and for instruction in righteousness. We believe that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are God's own written Word, given by the inspiration of God as the Holy Spirit guided holy men of old.
2. We believe in the only true God, who created all things, and upholds all things by the power of his Word. We believe that the Godhead eternally exists in three distinct persons, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; and that these three are one God, having precisely the same nature, attributes and perfections, and worthy of precisely the same homage, confidence and obedience.
3. We believe that by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin. We believe that man, originally created in the image and after the likeness of God, fell into sin and totally lost all spiritual life, becoming dead in trespasses and sins, and subject to the power of the devil.
4. We believe that there is no other way to God except through Jesus Christ. We believe that Christ died for our sins; that he was buried, and that he rose again on the third day according to the Scriptures and sat down at the right hand of God. We believe that Christ is received by faith alone, and that the moment we trust him as our substitute and therefore our Savior, we pass out of death into everlasting life.
5. We believe in the imminent personal return of Christ for his church, when Israel shall be restored to their own land, and the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord.
6. We believe that we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, and that we are called to walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
